Summary of Main Duties

Key accountabilities:

- Plan and conduct Serious Road Traffic Collision investigations.
- In line with the Road Death Investigation Manual and CPIA 1996, conduct investigations into Serious Road Traffic Incidents and Collisions which will include interviewing suspects, victims and witnesses.
- Conduct arrest, interview and process procedures and complete prosecution procedures.
- Prepare and present case files and present evidence in court and other hearings when required.
- Liaise with CPS, FCIU, CSI, FLC, FLO and Coroners as part of ongoing investigations.
- Attend Post Mortems as required by the Coroner/SIO.
- Provide specialist advice, support and knowledge on Serious Road Traffic Collisions and legislation and represent SYP at agency or Command meetings as required.
- Promote equality, diversity and Human Rights in all working practices and comply with health and safety legislation.
- Perform such other duties as reasonably correspond to the general character of the post, which are commensurate with its level of responsibility.
