Summary of Main Duties:

Carry out electrical/electronic servicing/repairs fitted to motor vehicles, motorcycles and plant as indicated in the South Yorkshire Police service policy.

The installation of specialised police equipment (police signs, videos etc).

The fabrication of installation equipment for specialist police equipment.

The removal of all police electrical equipment from vehicles for disposal.

Work as part of a team in the design and manufacture of equipment for specialist police uses.

Attend training courses on electrical/electronic and personal development, both in house and at suppliers/manufacturers bases.

Complete all approved Vehicle Fleet Management forms and miscellaneous paperwork in a precise and accurate manner.

Work at any of the Police workshops on a short or longer term assignments, as indicated by Vehicle Fleet Management.

Must possess a full driving licence and pass appropriate SYP Driving Test.
