### **SUMMARY OF MAIN DUTIES**

Whilst undertaking college course as part of apprenticeship, apprentice's will be paid the Apprentice salary and will undertake the below tasks with appropriate supervision.

On completion of appropriate Motor Vehicle Technician qualification (at college) will progress to Band C and will undertake the following tasks with supervision to gain relevant on the job experience.

On progression to Band D the employee will work to the Band D role profile.

- 1. Work towards responsibility for the repair, maintenance and servicing of motor vehicles, motor cycles, plant and auxiliary equipment owned, leased or loaned by South Yorkshire Police Authority.
- 2. To carry out to a high standard (under supervision) the damage repair/refurbishment and painting of Police vehicles, plant and equipment.
- 3. To carry out to a high standard (under supervision) the stripping and repair with the use of jigs and associated equipment, collision damage to motor vehicles.
- 4. To carry out to a high standard (under supervision) The removal and refitting of mechanical parts as required in the process of undertaking repairs.
- 5. Carry out recovery of police vehicles without supervision as required by management
- 6. Complete all documentation as required by management, in conjunction with repairs or maintenance carried out on police vehicles, plant or equipment
- 7. Relieve staff at other Workshops as directed, as and when required.
- 8. Attend training courses, both technical and personal development either inhouse or at manufacturers' premises occasionally requiring overnight stay.
